The **Marshaled Taxi Rank**, a Cork City Cares initiative, now operates on Friday and Saturday nights between Midnight and 3.00 a.m. on St. Patrick Street (beside Brown Thomas); this new city centre Marshalled Taxi Rank provides a monitored and serviced taxi rank for the security and comfort of Cork city centre night-time patrons.

The Rank is marshalled by security staff and monitored by An Garda Síochána via the city centre CCTV and Garda personnel. Patrons are invited to queue in an orderly manner and marshals on the rank are in contact with city taxi companies to call more taxis when needed to the rank.
